3: Central Implement Inc., the John Deere company sent a bill to TRC for \$238.01. The bill is for work the company said they performed to give TRC the repair estimate. \$233.10 is for labor. There are several questionable items on the bill that need to be addressed with the company.

8: Lyle and Jerry Pyle have installed a new gate at the club entrance. Lyle will be getting a cost estimate for replacing the broken swamp cooler in the workshop area of the office.

9: Replacement of the doors on the office were approved by an e-mail vote. The doors have been ordered and the project is expected to be completed by the end of the April.

10: Letter from Altar Valley Pistoleros, thanking TRC members for helping make the Brawley Wash Match a success. (attached),

11: The match directors have been notified that 2009 base calendar is on the website. They have been asked to review it for accuracy and report any discrepancies by April 14, 2008. The

only reported corrections are listed below;

a. TASC = Start times for June through the first match in September should be by 1800 hrs.

b. NBRSA 1000 yard Benchrest Matches need to be put back on the calendar, the second Saturday of every month from 0700 - 1400.
