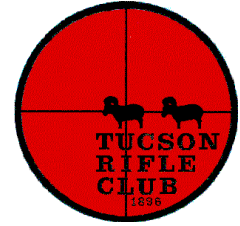
C: TRC business conducted between September 2009 and October 2009, (L. Novak).

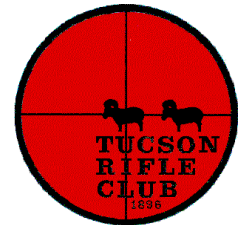

VOTING:
